Fragrant pandan leaves are combined with coconut milk to moisturise the hair and is suitable for those with dry brittle hair. The cooling version is the Limau Kasturi-Yoghurt Hair Mask that combines calamansi lime and yoghurt to cleanse and unclog the pores, perfect for those with oily hair. Both treatments conclude with a relaxing hair massage while guests relax on recliner chairs to watch black and white movie clips of P Ramlee, Malaysia's silver screen legend, on LCD screens embedded into the ceiling above them.
